AFTER SCHOOL – ACROSS THE STREET

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After School – Across the Street is a non-profit offering no cost after school tutoring services for McKnight Middle School students during the school year. This adult supervised program, along with high school volunteers, is designed to provide academic support to students after school on Tuesday afternoons from 2:35-4:00pm. Tutoring can be a positive experience if the student is in attendance each week. Students who ride the bus to McKnight Middle School will have the opportunity to ride an activity bus home at 4:00pm. Other students can either be picked up by their parents or walk home. Students will need to have this permission/commitment slip completed, signed and submitted in advance to participate in the program. Slips should be turned to the front office at McKnight or St. Matthews.

Technology and internet-based tools may be used to support student learning. These technologies improve student communication and collaboration skills, provide an authentic audience, and extend learning while building digital citizenship skills. Student access to technology requires responsible, courteous, efficient and legal use. It is important that students and parents recognize that information posted on the internet is public, permanent and needs to be appropriate.

Terms of technology usage include the following:

- 1. An agreement to follow the tutors/supervisors instructions when using technology.
- 2. An agreement to be polite, considerate, and to use appropriate language.
- 3. An agreement to report and/or help prevent any bullying, abuse or harm of others.
- 4. An agreement to tell an adult if I read, see, or access something inappropriate, or if I witness inappropriate use of technology
- 5. I agree to adhere with all filters and security measures.
- 6. An agreement not to share my passwords, except with my supervisor or parent/guardian.
- 7. An agreement to use only my own files and folders. I will not access another individual's files and folders without his/her permission.

- 8. An agreement not to reveal or post personal information belonging to myself or another person.
- 9. An agreement to adhere to copyright laws.10. An agreement to follow the technology check-out process.

The student's use of technology will be monitored and is neither private nor confidential to authorized supervisors within the tutoring program.

The expectations of participants in the after school tutoring program include: put downs and disrespectful language are not tolerated and no drugs or weapons are allowed on the premises. Students will not be allowed to leave the church grounds and return to the program for any reason. I have discussed appropriate behavior with my child and I understand that my child must follow all program rules.
